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Internationalization is one of the main development vectors of higher education in Ukraine. Internationalization of education involves extension of international contacts aiming to improve the education quality. Political, economical, socio-cultural factors influence internationalization process. Governmental support, extension of international scientific interaction, and involvement in up-to-date informational technologies promote internationalization process. The purpose of scientific research is to favor partnership between Ukraine and Poland. The goal is to represent the accomplished Ukrainian-Polish projects.

Different programs, projects, and events are implemented in the VNTU with the purpose of education internationalization. Introduction of European Credit Transfer and Accumulation System, tuition of foreign students, traveling, and active international scientific researches improve domestic education.

Interaction with Polish universities includes Politechnika Opolska, Politechnika Lubelska, Politechnika Świętokrzyska. Students gain dual degree education based on exchange programs. Educational programs are synchronized, so students may study at both Ukrainian and Polish universities simultaneously, and obtain internationally recognized diplomas.

VNTU invites students to study Polish and Chinese languages.

There is a cell of students' organization "BEST" (Board of European Students of Technology) in VNTU. This organization counts 97 cells in 34 European countries. Its purpose is to develop students. Different European countries host annual training courses for foreign students of technology. "BEST" is an outstanding example of internationalization, organized by students. Internationalization is integration of foreign component into scientific, research, and educational activity in higher education institutions. It has positive impact on domestic economy, education quality, and students' training.
